Memorial Day

For the past several years some neighbors have created the American flag display along Spruce Drive on Memorial Day, Independence Day and Veteran's Day. Additional flags have been purchased to also put them in the public/common areas on Katherine and Brant Circles. To accomplish the additional displays, more people are needed to help with the set up.

We will meet on Monday May 26th at 7:00 am at the corner of Spruce, Katherine and Brant. If possible, please bring a long tape measure, and tools to dig small holes in the ground (a hammer and long screwdriver work well).

If you would like a special flag for your front yard to honor a veteran or current serviceperson in your family, please let myself or Pat Bastian know. We have identified some neighbors that served and want to make sure we show appreciation for all of you. if If you have any questions about the display please let us know.

Landscape Improvement Update

As most of you know, the board approved hiring Wasco Nursery last fall to do an evaluation of our current landscape. Herb Buhr and myself, spent a morning going through all of the HOA's property evaluating the current design, plant material, and current issues with Matt from Wasco. Wasco gave us a very detailed plan of things that needed to be taken care of sooner than later (diseased trees and shrubs).

The landscape committee then reviewed the list and decided to break down the tasks into a 3 year plan.

We went through and picked the items that needed immediate attention submitted the list to the board and received approval. Katherine Circle has the most issues, so the majority of the work this year will take place there.

I have listed for you the work that is going to be performed sometime the middle of June.

The mailbox area on Katherine will be completely redesigned and new plant materials installed.

In the circle of Katherine the four Pear trees will be removed and replaced with 2 Emerald City Tulip Trees and 2 Expresso Kentucky Coffee Trees

Behind the gazebo, were there was a pear tree that we lost last year there will be a 7' White Fir put in to replace it.

There is a drainage issue on the west side of Katherine that is washing away the mulch and granite boulders will be put in to contain the mulch.


The River Birch at 574 Katherine is diseased and will be removed and a Firespire American Hornbeam will be planted to replace it.

The backyard (facing Sangamon) 532 Katherine will receive new bushes

The backyard at 522 Katherine will receive new bushes to replace the dead ones we removed last year.

Brant Circle will get a replacement tree for the pear we lost last summer. The mailbox area will have a new design and the area where the tree was located will be completely removed and a new planting area will incorporate the mailboxes. A Regal Prince Oak will be added into the new design.

I have included a drawing of the new design, which will be the same for both circles. The only difference is Brant will have the Regal Prince Oak.



This is the mailbox design for both Katherine and Brant Circles. The only thing different is that you see the Royal Prince Oak that will be installed on Brant. There will not be a tree included on Katherines design. All of these plants will provide a variety of color throughout the spring, summer and fall.

SPRING CLEANING TIME
